Sit	Sitz	Seets	Commands the dog into a sitting position
Down	Platz	platts	Commands the dog into a down position
Stand	Steh	shtay	Commands the dog to a standing position
Stay	Bleib	<b>bly</b> -b	Commands the dog to stay as is
Heel	Fuss (by the foot)	fooss	Commands the dog to follow right by your knee
Come	Komm	come	Commands the dog to come to you
Here	Hier	hee-er	Commands the dog to come to you
Come Here	Komm Hier	come hee-er	Commands the dog to come to you
Forward	Voraus	forr-awss	Sends the dog forward in a straight line
Attack	Packen	Packen	Sends the dog to attack
Attack	Fass	fass (that's an easy one)	Sends the dog to attack
Out	Aus	awss	Commands the dog to out the bite and stay
Guard	Pass auf	pass-awf	Commands the dog to stay and guard
At/On Object	Auf Objekt	awf- <b>ob</b> -ject	Commands the dog on the object to guard For training ONLY, NOT ALLOWED in trial
Search and Bring	Such und Bring	tsuuk-oont-brrring ("und" may be dropped)	Sends the dog to retrieve a thrown object
Give	Gib	gibb	Request object after a retrieve
Search and Bark	Such und Gib Laut	tsuuk-oont-gibblawt	Sends the dog to find the decoy and bark when found
Jump	Норр	hopp	Commands the dog to jump the obstacle
[H]up	Норр	hopp	Commands the dog to jump the obstacle
Place	Stelle	shteh-lar (almost stellar but starting with the <i>sh</i> sound)	Repositions the dog before a return jump Only AFTER the judge's horn signal (all position commands also allowed)
Hello   Good Day	Guten Tag	Goo-ten-tahk	Not a dog command
Good Bye   See You Later	Auf Wiedersehen	awf- <b>vee</b> -derr-zehn	Not a dog command
